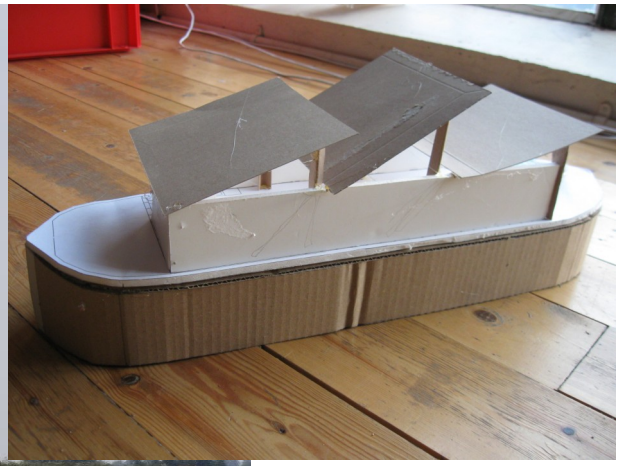


What is it with these barges....

We believe they were made in 1944 as part of the War effort, either as water carriers or fuel barges. These FCBs, or Ferro Concrete Barges (or Ferro Cement Barges) were found up and down estuaries and canals as far away as New York and Amsterdam. Mostly made on the East Coast of England, with a flint aggregate, the concrete takes up to 50 years to fully cure and reach its full strength. More recently many of these hulls have been abandoned and broken up, so we are pleased to be re-using this one as our new office.
